2016 Pinot Noir

NOTES

The 2016 Tower Pinot Noir draws fruit from two vineyards set in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA. A single blend is created each year to showcase the nuances of the vintage as interpreted by two distinctly different sites. The wine is aged 12 months in barrel then bottled and aged for an additional year before release.

Cherry, violet and sweet baking spices commingle with notes of warm forest floor. On the palate earthiness meets briar patch, finishing with ripe citrus marmalade, layering freshness with concentration. Tannins build gradually, creating length without compromising the elegance of the wine. The finish is lifted bright, filled with energy.
